### THE SCHOOL

Morrison Academy Taichung is the central campus of Morrison Academy. Morrison Academy operates three high schools (grades 9-12) and four elementary/middle schools with a system-wide enrollment of 987. Morrison Academy was founded in 1952 to meet the educational needs of the children of missionaries throughout Taiwan. Morrison seeks to develop a Christ-centered school culture in which all students, from missionary and non-missionary families, experience a Biblically-integrated quality education. The vision for our learners guides students to develop the knowledge, discernment and abilities to dynamically impact their world in a positive way.



### STUDENT BODY & FACULTY

Taichung high school enrollment for the 2020-2021 school year is 186, with students from 13 countries, predominantly the U.S. and Canada. Children of missionaries and other church workers comprise 39% of the student body and 61% are from business families. 13% of students board in campus dorms or with staff families. Of the 48 members of the class of 2021, nine nations are represented: U.S., Canada, South Korea, the Philippines, Burkina Faso, New Zealand, Guinea-Bissau, Germany and the Marshall Islands. There are 45 students in the junior class, 51 in the sophomore class, and 42 in the freshman class. Four nations are represented by a 38 member high school faculty. Of the 32 instructional staff, 20 have advanced degrees.

Morrison Academy offers a rigorous, college preparatory curriculum that incorporates a standards based approach to grading.\*

Of the 48 students in the class of 2021, the highest GPA in the class is 4.22 on a 4.0 scale.

- First quartile GPA **3.99**
- Second quartile GPA **3.82**
- Third quartile GPA **3.51**

\*Beginning in the 2019-2020 school year, Morrison Academy transitioned to a standards based model for grading in all courses. To reflect this new model for grade reporting, student transcripts will no longer display a percentage.

Grade Point Average (GPA) is computed at the end of each semester beginning with grade 9. Courses that are not part of an accredited American curriculum are exempt when computing GPA. Morrison weights grades on a 5.0 scale only for the Advanced Placement courses listed. \*\*Beginning with the class of 2020, students who take AP courses online through Seven Star Academy, will also receive a grade weighting.
